

Sigma Kappa Alumnae Spring Thing Rules

How to enter:

- Starting on May 1, 2019, sign up to receive your Spring Thing activity card at sigmakappa.org/Alumnae-Spring-Thing.
- Be available to travel during August 1, 2019- November 15, 2019.
- Complete the four colored squares on your Spring Thing activity card, then return to the Spring Thing event page and submit a contest entry form no later than 5/24/2019 at sigmakappa.org/Alumnae-Spring-Thing

We will check:

- That your national alumnae dues are current as of 5/24/2019 (as proof of membership in an alumnae chapter)
- That you have updated your information in the Sigma Kappa member database ("Give Us Your Digits" square).
- That you have submitted a photo to us at sigmakappa.org/Alumnae-Spring-Thing] ("Say Cheese!" square).
- That you have submitted answers to the two trivia questions ("Priorities, Priorities" square and "S.O.S" square.)

What you win:

Grand Prize

A trip for you and a guest to Waterville, Maine. Trip includes flight (up to \$500 per ticket), hotel, a daily stipend, and coordinated tours at Colby College. Winner will be featured on Sigma Kappa's social media and publications.

First Prize

Two first prize winners will receive Sigma Kappa gift baskets.

Official Rules:

NO PURCHASE OR PAYMENT IS NECESSARY TO ENTER. A PURCHASE OR PAYMENT OF ANY KIND WILL NOT INCREASE YOUR CHANCES OF WINNING. Void where prohibited. U.S. law governs.

OPEN ONLY to members of Sigma Kappa alumnae chapters as of the date of entry,

including the virtual chapter, who are at least twenty one (21) years old at the time of entry.

This sweepstakes is sponsored by Sigma Kappa Sorority (the 'Sponsor'). This promotion may be advertised on Facebook but this promotion is in no way sponsored, endorsed, or administered by, or associated with, Facebook.

Spring Thing Sweepstakes (the 'Sweepstakes') is open only to legal residents of the fifty (50) United States (and the District of Columbia) who are at least twenty one (21) years old and alumnae chapter members of Sigma Kappa Sorority. Proof of residency, age and alumnae chapter membership may be required. Sigma Kappa national headquarters staff, national council members, Sigma Kappa Foundation trustees and Sigma Kappa National Housing Corporation board of directors and the immediate family and household members of such individuals are not eligible to win. 'Immediate family members' shall mean parents, stepparents, children, stepchildren, siblings, stepsiblings, or spouses, regardless of residence. 'Household members' shall mean people who share the same residence at least three months a year, whether related or not. Other national volunteers are eligible to win, but if convention expenses are already covered by the national organization, the grand prize will be limited to the listed expenses for one qualified guest. Local advisors are eligible to win and, if a local chapter has already covered the costs of the winner to attend convention, the local chapter will be reimbursed.

In order to enter the Sweepstakes or receive a prize, you must fully comply with the Official Rules and, by entering, you represent and warrant that you agree to be bound by these Official Rules and the decisions of the Sponsor, whose decisions shall be binding and final in all respects relating to this Sweepstakes. During the Sweepstakes Entry Period you may complete the online entry form by entering here sigmakappa.org/Alumnae-Spring-Thing and clicking submit (the 'Submission'). You will be required to confirm that you have read and agree be bound by the Official Rules. ALL ENTRIES MUST BE RECEIVED BY 11:59 PM EDT ON May 24, 2019. Limit of one entry per member during the Sweepstakes Entry Period. Sponsor is not responsible for lost, late, incomplete, invalid, unintelligible or misdirected entries all of which will be ineligible to win a prize. In the event of a dispute as to any entrant, the authorized account holder of the email address used to enter will be deemed to be the entrant. The 'authorized account holder' is the natural person assigned an email address by an Internet access provider, online service provider or other organization responsible for assigning email addressed for the domain associated with the

submitted address. Potential winner of the prize may be required to show proof of being the authorized account holder to be awarded the prize. All entries become the sole and exclusive property of Sponsor and will not be returned or cancelled.

Two (2) First Prizes will be awarded, each consisting of a gift basket with Sigma Kappa Sorority merchandise. (Approximate Retail Value (ARV) of each First Prize: \$50.)

One (1) Grand Prize will be awarded, consisting of (a) round-trip coach air transportation for two (2) (up to \$500 per ticket) to Portland, Maine, from a major commercial airport in the continental United States, nearest to the primary residence of the winner and her guest provided that the Sponsor reserves the right to substitute ground transportation for air transportation if the winner resides within 150 miles of Waterville, Maine; (b) one (1) hotel accommodation for three(3) nights in Waterville, Maine (one double occupancy room and room tax only) ; (c) a single amount of \$300 to. (Total Approximate Retail Value (ARV): \$4,000)

Winners will be determined in a random drawing on or about May 30, 2019 from among all eligible entries under the supervision of an independent panel of judges from Sponsor whose decisions are final and binding. All potential winners will be notified by telephone and must respond within one (1) business day to give a valid email address where notification of potential winner status and required documents can be sent. If prize notification is undeliverable, or if a potential winner does not respond to the prize notification telephone call within the time specified or if the potential winner cannot be contacted for any reason, including an invalid telephone number, during the time Sponsor must reach, if the Affidavit is not complete and received by the sponsor within the time required, or in the event of non-compliance with these Official Rules, the prize will be forfeited, and an alternate winner will be selected at random from the remaining eligible entries. All travel companions must be at least 21 years old at the time of travel.

By entering this sweepstakes, any personal information entrants submit will be disclosed to the Sponsor and will be used only by us for the limited purpose of verifying eligibility to enter and contacting potential prize winners. This promotion may be advertised on Facebook but entrants will be providing information to Sigma Kappa Sorority and not to Facebook.

If, in Sponsor's opinion, there is any suspected or actual evidence of electronic or non-electronic tampering with any portion of this sweepstakes, or if technical difficulties or technical corruption (including a computer virus or system malfunction) compromise the integrity of the sweepstakes, Sponsor reserves the right to terminate the sweepstakes and select winners from among all eligible entries received prior to termination. Should the sweepstakes be terminated prior to the stated expiration date, notice will be posted

as www.sigmakappa.org. Any attempt to deliberately damage the content or operation of this drawing is unlawful and subject to legal action by the Sponsor and its agents.
